These buildings are facilitated with modern amenities, elevators and good furniture. All the lecture halls are provided with a sophisticated Audio-Video system. The institute is having a total of 4GBPS network facility to cater to the whole community of the institute. Further the whole campus is supported with Wi-Fi facilities. The institute is having electricity connections one 4001 kVA for permanent campus and 888.8 kVA for the transit campus. The institute has 17 science labs to cater to undergraduate and postgraduate students and that can accommodate a total of 350 students at a time. The institute has a total of 1608 functional computers to cater to the requirements of the institute. The institute is having hostel accommodation for 2300 students in Permanent and Transit Campus. Further these hostels are supported by four messes which can cater the students' dinning. The institute also has residential facilities for its faculty and staff members.
