Salient Points

- ▶ B.Sc-B.Ed (Secondary Stage) is a 4-year integrated Dual Major programme, with one major in Education and the other in any of the following three science disciplines: Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics.
- ▶ A candidate will be allotted any one of the above Disciplinary Majors in science in addition to that in Education based on his/her score in the National Common Entrance Test (NCET).
- ▶ The candidates who have passed class XII in Science Stream having Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as the combination of subjects are eligible to apply for any of the above disciplinary Majors.
- ▶ They must have appeared for the test in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as the domain subjects in the NCET conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).
- ▶ Candidate must have scored at least 60% (for UR and EWS), 55% (for OBC), 50% (for SC/ST/PWD) mark in their 10+2 exam (or equivalent qualifying exam)
- ▶ Admission to the programme will be based on the NCET total score secured by the candidates in all seven subjects (e.g., Languages 1 and 2, Teaching Aptitude, General Test, and three relevant Domain-specific Subjects) covering four different sections.
- ▶ If a candidate is absent in the NCET Test of any of the seven subjects, that candidate will not be considered for admission.
- ▶ The admission counselling for the B.Sc-B.Ed programme of IIT Ropar will be conducted by IIT Ropar.
- ▶ Applications are to be submitted online through (<https://www.iitrpr.ac.in/bsc-bed>).
- ▶ Candidates seeking admission have to pay a non-refundable application fee of ₹ 500/- for Male (GEN/OBC/EWS) and ₹ 250/- for Female/SC/ST/PwD.
- ▶ The total number of seats available at IIT Ropar is 50, distributed across three disciplinary majors. Details of the seat matrix are given in Table 1.
- ▶ Candidates should have been born on or after August 1, 2006 (for UR and EWS), August 1, 2003 (for OBC) and August 1, 2001 (for SC/ST/PWD).
- ▶ The candidate needs to fill a separate application form for each disciplinary major (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics).





About The Institute

The Indian Institute of Technology Ropar started functioning from the academic year 2008-09 from the campus of IIT Delhi, the mentor institute. The foundation stone laying ceremony was held on 24 February 2009. The Indian Institute of Technology Ropar was initially registered under the Societies' Registration Act 1860 on 29 July 2009. Subsequently, the Institute has been established by Act of Parliament namely, the Institutes of Technology Act (Amendment) Act 2012 (No. 34 of 2012). The Institute has shifted to its permanent campus in 2018 and currently operates from its permanent campus. The permanent campus of IIT Ropar is spread across 501 acres of land located in Rupnagar in the lap of nature at the banks of river Satluj. The Institute has been awarded the 5 Star GRIHA (Green Rating for Integrated Habitat Assessment) rating, one of the highest national ratings for Green Buildings. A total of 2,15,739 square meters of area is dedicated for academic and administration blocks along with accommodation for staff and faculty along with sports and hostel facilities. All hostels are well furnished along with common rooms for recreational activities for each hostel. The campus also has an expansive and airy common dining area. Naturally, there is no compromise with facilities regarding academics and laboratories for undertaking practical or doing some research. New state-of-the-art equipment are available for the students to use in labs. Apart from these academic facilities, other perks of being at IIT ROPAR include excellent sports facilities (different play fields for each sport such as cricket, football, tennis, badminton, basketball, volleyball, etc), utility block, student activity centre (equipment and rooms for the various club activities and other student interest group activities), gymkhana, air-conditioned libraries with plethora of books, cafeterias, gymnasium, medical centre with top notch 24x7 medical facilities. The Indian Institute of Technology Ropar is ranked 32nd in the engineering category in NIRF 2025 (National Institutional Ranking Framework) and overall ranked 56th. IIT Ropar is committed to provide state-of-the-art technical education in a variety of fields. The Institute is facilitating transmission of knowledge in keeping with the latest developments in pedagogy. At present, the Institute offers the degree of Bachelor of Technology in Artificial Intelligence and Data Engineering, Civil Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Digital Agriculture, Electrical Engineering, Electrical Engineering (Integrated Circuit Design and Technology), Engineering Physics, Engineering Science, Mechanical Engineering, Mathematics & Computing and Metallurgical & Materials Engineering. It offers the MSc degree in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and M.Sc in Data Science (jointly with IIM Amritsar). It offers the degree of Master of Technology in Computer Science and Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Artificial Intelligence, Autonomous Systems & Drone Technology, E-Waste Resources Engineering & Management and Biomedical Engineering. All the departments of the Institute offer a doctoral degree. The Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) is a new addition to its ever-expanding vision of inclusive professional and need-based education.

The Institute has held 14 convocations so far. The 2022 entry batch of UG students is about to receive their degrees in the 15th convocation. Presently the Institute has 1905 UG students, 602 PG students, 980 PhD students. Apart from B.Tech degrees the Institute also awards M.Tech, MSc. & PhD degrees. The overall academic system of IIT Ropar is designed to provide science-based engineering





education that will produce quality engineers and scientists. IIT Ropar has implemented a new curriculum from 2017. About the Programme

The Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) is a 4-year integrated programme under which the candidates will have a Dual Major undergraduate degree in a specific science discipline along with B.Ed. Keeping in view the mandate of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and subsequent initiatives by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) (Ministry of Education, Government of India, New Delhi), the Department of HSS at this institute offers B.Sc-B.Ed (Secondary Stage) with one Major in Education and the other in any of the following three science disciplines: Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics. Apart from preparing teachers for the reconfigured school education system in the country, the ITEP will help impart disciplinary knowledge in the above-mentioned subjects so that the candidates will gain in-depth knowledge. It would also ensure their admission to higher studies in the disciplinary streams, including higher professional education.

The ITEP at IIT Ropar is of 4-year duration across eight semesters of study. It is a Dual- Major Bachelor's Degree programme, with one Major in Education and the other in any of the following three science disciplines: Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics. In addition, it intends to develop among candidate-teachers the ethics of social engagement, and capacities such as problem-solving, critical and creative thinking, communication skills, ethical and moral reasoning, etc. The candidates joining this programme shall specialize in the secondary stage of school education, which will qualify them to become teachers at that stage. The curriculum and detailed syllabi can be accessed by visiting <https://www.iitrpr.ac.in/>. The B.Sc- B.Ed programme is credit-based and thus offers the flexibility to progress at one's own pace. A minimum level of performance is essential for satisfactory progress.

ADMISSION TO THE PROGRAMME

Admission to the programme will be made through the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA). The results of the NCET will be used for admission. The seat matrix of the three Disciplinary Majors under B.Sc-B.Ed programme of IIT Ropar is given in Table 1.

Candidates who have appeared NCET and have secured a valid score are eligible to apply for B.Sc-B.Ed 2026 admission at IIT Ropar, provided they satisfy the following:

- ▶ The candidates must have passed the class XII Examinations in Science Stream with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics in the combination of subjects.
- ▶ They must have appeared for the test in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as the domain subjects in the NCET conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).
- ▶ Candidate must have scored at least 60% (for UR and EWS), 55% (for OBC), 50% (for SC/ST/PWD) mark in their 10+2 exam (or equivalent qualifying exam)
- ▶ Proof of having passed Class XII and having secured requisite marks must be submitted at the time of submitting the application. Original documents must be furnished to IIT Ropar at the time of admission.
- ▶ Candidates should have been born on or after August 1, 2006 (for UR and EWS), August 1, 2003 (for OBC) and August 1, 2001 (for SC/ST/PWD).

Shortlisting Criteria

Candidates must obtain a minimum 50 percentile/score (UR/EWS), 45 percentile/score (OBC) and 40 percentile/score (SC/ST/PWD) in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics subject but the merit will be prepared on the basis of percentile/score obtained of the respective subject in which he/she applied. The merit list will be prepared on the basis of following shortlisting criteria:

- a) 50% weightage of percentile/score obtained in the respective science domain subject (i.e. Physics/Mathematics/Chemistry) in which candidate applied.
- b) Combined 30% weightage of percentile/score obtained in other 02 Science subjects (i.e. from Physics/Mathematics/Chemistry).
- c) 20% weightage of percentile/score obtained in other linguistic subjects.

Note: In case the NTA releases both percentile and score, the percentile shall be considered for shortlisting

For candidates satisfying the ERs, MEQs and other necessary requirements, based on their NCET score, seats will be allotted without any additional interview or written test. At the time of admission, all admitted candidates may have to submit a Physical Fitness certificate from a registered medical practitioner in the prescribed form to IIT Ropar. The admitted candidates may also have to undergo a Physical Fitness test by a medical board constituted by the Institute. In case candidates are not found physically fit to pursue their chosen programme of study, their admission is liable to be cancelled.

If a Board awards only letter grades without providing an equivalent percentage of marks on the grade sheet, the candidate should obtain a certificate from the Board specifying the equivalent marks and submit it at the time of acceptance of the allocated seat. In case, such a certificate is not provided, the decision taken by IIT Ropar will be final.





Reservation of Seats

Indian nationals belonging to different categories are admitted under the seats reserved for them in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government of India.

Under each Disciplinary Major, a certain number of seats, as listed in Table 1, is reserved for candidates belonging to various categories. Candidates who seek admission under the SC or ST category must submit the requisite certificates issued by a competent authority as specified in Annexure 1. Candidates who seek admission under the OBC-NCL or EWS Category must submit an OBC-NCL or EWS Certificate issued by a competent authority as specified in Annexure 1, in a format similar to that shown in Annexure 2 for OBC-NCL and Annexure 3 for EWS. Valid certificates for OBC-NCL or EWS issued on or after April 1, 2026, should be submitted for application processing. However, candidates securing seats under the OBC-NCL or EWS category may be required to show a valid certificate to IIT Ropar at the time of joining.

Candidates who seek admission under the PwD category must submit a disability certificate (refer to Annexure 1) or a Unique Disability Identification (UDID) certificate. Benefits of reservations would be given only to those who have benchmark disability, i.e., not less than 40% impairment, irrespective of the type of disability. Such candidates must submit, along with the filled-in Application Form, the Certificate of Disability from a Government Medical Board and should be fit to pursue the Programme. The certificate should preferably be in the format given in Form 1 or Form 2, or Form 3 (as applicable) in the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017. The disability percentage of candidates selected for admission in the PwD category may also be required to be certified by a Medical Board, duly constituted by the Admitting Institute.

Candidates must note that the benefits of reservation will be given to them subject to verification of documents. If it is discovered at any stage that a candidate has used a false/fake/incorrect document or has furnished false, incorrect, or incomplete information, in order to avail of the benefits of reservation, then such a candidate shall be excluded from the admission process. In case such a candidate has already been given admission, the admission shall stand cancelled.

▶▶ APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Applications for Admissions to B.Sc.-B.Ed programme at IIT Ropar must be submitted online at <https://www.iitrpr.ac.in/bsc-bedby> paying a non-refundable application fee of ₹500/- for Male (GEN/OBC/EWS) and ₹ 250/- for Female/SC/ST/PwD. Candidates of the NCET 2026 Result List will be eligible to apply for admission. Only one duly completed Application Form should be submitted. The candidates are requested to verify the details on the candidate portal <https://www.iitrpr.ac.in/bsc-bed> before the start of the admission process and contact IIT Ropar via email (office-academics-pg3@iitrpr.ac.in), in case of any discrepancy. The list of documents required for applying is given in Annexure 4. Based on the required Test Paper(s) (Domain-specific) qualified, a candidate can apply to One or more Science Major(s) in addition to a Major in Education under B.Sc.-B.Ed. Program under separately B.Sc.-B.Ed programme covered under that Test Paper(s), subject to the fulfillment of the MEQs and ERs of IIT Ropar.

The Candidate need to fill separate application form for each Science Major (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics).





▶▶ IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE:

- ▶ Applicants are requested to periodically check the IIT Ropar website <https://www.iitrpr.ac.in/bsc-bed> for updates and the Candidate Portal for the status of their applications. They should also check the messages sent to their registered e-mail ID.
- ▶ Incomplete applications or applications that are not supported by valid documents will be rejected. The application fee, if paid, would not be refunded for applications that are rejected. The Application Form for admission will not be considered if the fee is not received by IIT Ropar before the application deadline. No intimation regarding the rejection of the application form will be sent to the candidates.
- ▶ Applicants who are not allotted seats in a round may get seats allotted in the subsequent rounds. Applicants who fail to accept seats offered at any stage will not be considered further in the admission process.
- ▶ Last date for the payment of the fees for the seats allotted in each round may not be relaxed in any case. If the candidate does not accept the seat offered or payment is not made within the stipulated period, the offer gets automatically cancelled. No other requests or correspondence on this matter will be entertained.
- ▶ Candidates should note that being on the NCET Result List neither guarantees nor provides any automatic entitlement for admission. Admissions shall be made in order of merit and depending on the number of seats available at IIT Ropar.
- ▶ The offer of admission to a candidate made during the seat allocation process would remain provisional, subject to the fulfillment of all the requirements stipulated by IIT Ropar as per the fixed deadlines.
- ▶ Payment has to be made using credit card/debit card/net banking/UPI (additional Bank charges may apply depending on the mode of payment).
- ▶ With regard to the interpretation of the provisions on any matter the decision of IIT Ropar shall be final and binding on all the parties concerned.
- ▶ NTA has the overall responsibility of conducting NCET 2026. In case of any claims or disputes related to NCET 2026, the NTA may be consulted.

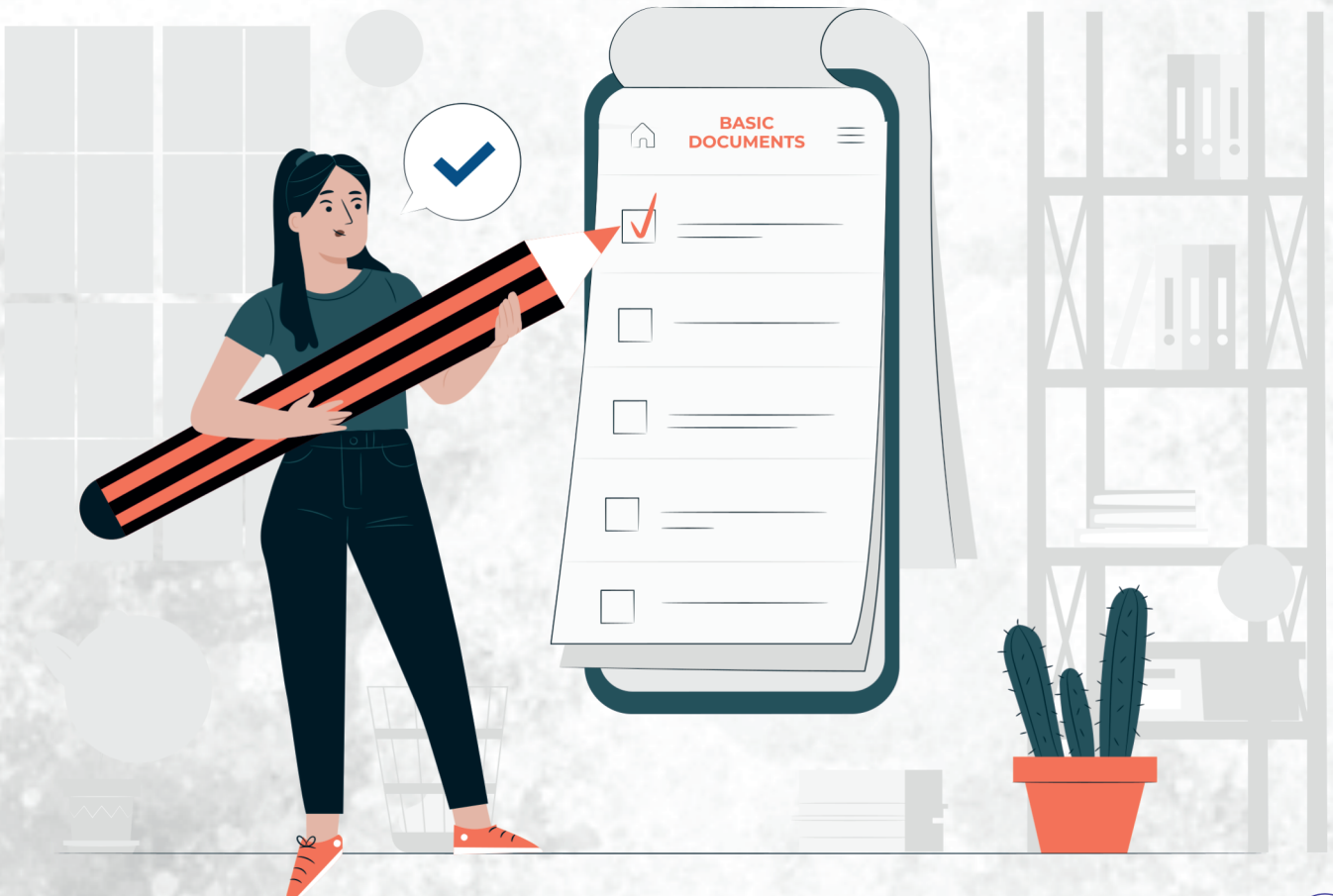
