14	IIT Ropar	Yes	IIT Ropar follows Zero Tolerance Policy against Ragging. At the time of admission, an affidavit from the students and his/her parents by informing the rules and regulations on curbing the menace of ragging and penal provisions are being taken. It is ensured all student and their parents fill the online undertaking on anti-ragging declaration given by UGC. Anti-Ragging Committees (ARC) and Anti-Ragging Squads (ARS) are formed at the beginning of academic semester. Posters on curbing the practice of ragging are put up in the various locations of the campus viz hostels, academic areas, mess, Utility area etc. Anti-ragging compliance sheet filled up, after completing each mentioned task in the compliance sheet. Anti-Ragging talks are also arranged to apprise the students about the menace of ragging and its complete prohibition in the Institute. Also, after the joining of new students, (during their Induction), a dedicated Institute Student Mentorship Program (ISMP) is run for a period of month in which students are informed that the campus is totally ragging free and any such act should be promptly reported to the Anti-Ragging helpline numbers clearly displayed on the Institute website.
