

Steps for resetting/generating LDAP password (Single Sign on for all internal applications)

Changing password through MOODLE

1. Open Moodle servers <http://medh2.iitrpr.ac.in>, <http://medh3.iitrpr.ac.in> , <http://medh4.iitrpr.ac.in>



2. Click on Login and then click on Forgotten your username or password to reset your password (as shown in screenshot)

3. Fill all the necessary fields as shown in screenshot below, by default your username is your **entry number** and password is the one which which you are using to login into computer lab of CSE department or accessing VPN
