#### PROGRAMS

The Board considered the recommendations of the Finance Committee for revision in fees for UG and PG programs (including National and International students) at IIT Ropar. The tuition fees will also be increased for PG & PhD programs (the tuition fees for UG will be as decided by IIT Council). The Chairman suggested incorporating the inflation and accordingly increases the fees AY 2026-27 onwards at the rate of inflation subject to minimum increase of @5% every academic year.

RESOLVED THAT the implementation of Open to All Teaching (OAT) program at IIT Ropar is approved as follows:

- Course tuition fees may be based on L-T-P structure. Thus, tuition fees per course = Rs. 5520 \* (L+T+P/2). The income generated may be shared as: 30% instructors, 30% Department (including TAs, if any), 30% Institute and 10% Academic Section for advertising, infrastructure, resources etc. UG TAs may also be hired when needed.
- Opening of a UG/PG course to the outside students (in the online mode only) will be on the discretion of the faculty member teaching the course.
- Opening of a UG/ PG course to the outside students (in the online mode only) will be subject to approval of the Senate on the recommendation of ACUGS/ACRPGS.
- The outside students joining the course in online mode will give examinations in online mode only and get the credits added into their Academic Bank of Credits account.
- This proposal may be considered initially for 1 year after which it may be reviewed and revised, if needed, based on the experience.

- Detailed guidelines be framed as per the need.
- The courses will be opened to International students as well, for whom the fees per course per semester will be 1.5 time that for the Indian students, i.e. Rs. 8,280\*(L+T+P/2) for the international students.
- The fees are similar to that for the Non-Degree UG program for the visiting students, approved by the 45th Senate (Item 14; via Resolution no. S45/R14/22/646).

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the fees be reviewed after completion of one year of the program.
