As you would be aware, Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) has notified public procurement policy for MSEs Order, 2012 which mandates 25% of the total annual procurement from MSEs by all the Central Ministries/ Departments and CPSEs including 4% from the MSEs owned by SC/ST entrepreneurs and 3% from the MSEs owned by women entrepreneurs.

An MoU has been signed with Government e-Marketplace (GeM) and Common Service Centre (CSC) to mobilize maximum number of MSEs and to provide handholding support to the MSEs on boarding with GeM portal for participating government purchase programme through GeM portal. Accordingly chief secretaries of all the States and UTs have been requested vide D.O. letter No. 21(13)/2017-MA pt-III dated 21st May, 2018 from Secretary, MSME that respective department of the State Government may be directed to mobilise maximum number of enterprises to register with GeM portal.

Further, Reserve Bank of India in their recommendation has also emphasized that more MSEs need to be encourage to registered on the portal and Government may make it mandatory for PSUs / Government Department to meet their MSME procurement target through GeM portal

I would be grateful if all the procuring authorities/Deptt. and CPSEs working under your administrative control could be advised to procure goods & services from MSEs through GeM Portal only to meet 25% of annual procurement target from MSEs including 4% from MSEs owned by SC/ST and 3% MSEs owned by Women.
